Troy, New York



Adaptive reuse project involving renovation of underutilized basement space in the Burdett Building. The location was chosen because of its downtown proximity and adjacency to Troy's Riverfront Park. Natural light is introduced from the riverside through restoration of old cargo doors and windows and from the street side through an atrium cut to provide an inviting entrance.

The entrance is accented with a full scale partial replica of the Burden Iron Works waterwheel, an important historic icon. The project received New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation certification.
